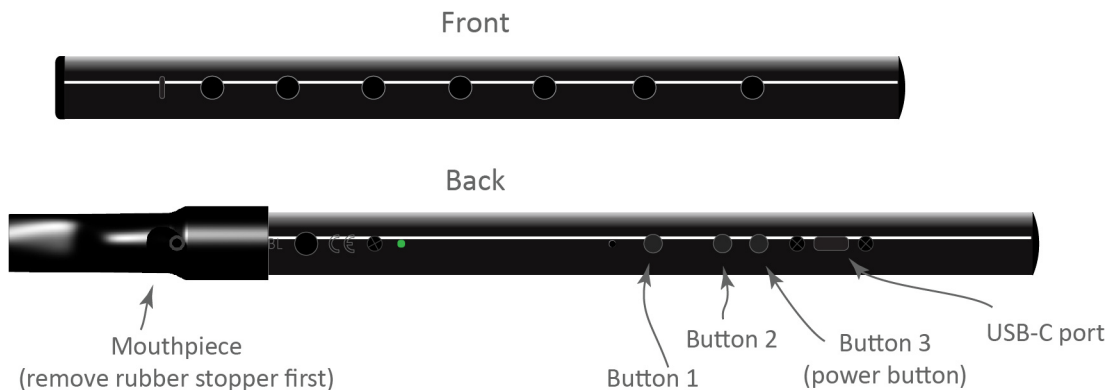




# WARBL<sup>®</sup> 2

## Quick Start Guide



### Power on the WARBL2

To turn on the WARBL2 click button 3 (the power button). It will turn off after 5 minutes of inactivity or you can hold down button 3 for three seconds to turn it off.

### Connect the WARBL2 to your device with BLE MIDI

The easiest way to start using the WARBL2 is to connect it to an iOS device (iPhone or iPad) using BLE MIDI. To connect the first time use a free app like KORG BLE MIDI Connect. Once you use an app to pair the WARBL2 it should reconnect automatically each time you turn it on, so you can just open a MIDI app if your choice and begin playing.

### Make music!

Once you have paired the WARBL2, you can open the MIDI app of your choice and begin playing. Recommended apps include Celtic Sounds MIDI Module, Thumbjam, and SoundFonts. If the WARBL toneholes don't respond as you would expect, you will need to calibrate them (see below).

### Change Settings with the WARBL Configuration Tool

Download the free WARBL iOS app. If the WARBL2 is connected by BLE, when you open the app it should connect and display the current firmware version. If not, click the "Connect to WARBL" button.

The first thing you may want to do is calibrate the optical sensors (see the User Manual or the videos on the WARBL site for more information). The User Manual contains extensive documentation of the Configuration Tool.

### Further options:

WARBL2 also works with PC, Mac, Android, or hardware MIDI modules, and can use either a USB or BLE connection on many devices. See the User Manual and the WARBL FAQ page for more information about other devices and connections.
